## *The Blythe Municipal Golf Course is open for business!*

The City of Blythe would like to take this opportunity to inform you of some new and exciting things happening at the Blythe Municipal Golf Course. We are about to embark on the annual re-seeding program and the course will be in great playing condition in time for the winter season. City staff and a number of loyal volunteers have spent countless hours maintaining the course, bringing it back to pristine playing condition. It looks wonderful, and we invite you to come up and check it out for yourself.

We are happy to report that the Annual Pass and Daily Green Fee Rates will not increase this year. We are also excited about new rate fees in the works. This includes an Early Bird and Twilite Special. Anyone playing before 8:00 a.m. on the back 9 and after 1:00 p.m. on the front 9 can play 9 holes with cart for \$20.00 and \$15.00 without a cart. We have also added a non-resident Junior Rate of \$10.00 for the day with the local Junior Rate remaining at \$5.00 daily.

Additionally, the City has already installed directional signs around town leading travelers from the Lovekin Blvd. and 7<sup>th</sup> Street exits to the golf course. Also on the drawing board is a series of freeway billboards that will alert eastbound drivers on the I-10 that there is golf course in Blythe!

Also in the works are a point-of-sale system for the pro shop and an entrance sign.

The City is now accepting proposals from persons interested in operating the snack shack, formerly the Coach's Corner in the Pro Shop. The City is positive that a new operator will be in place and ready to serve the golfing community in time for the winter season.
