Committee Reports:

Architectural - Don Avison said there have been 2 permits this month, one for an awning and one for an air conditioner.

Maintenance - Gary Hayward reported the committees has re-coated the roof on the hall, repaired some tiles near the water dispenser, installed a new back-flow valve, hung some mop holders in the kitchen, repairs done in the washroom and begun the bricks at the exit gates.

Social - Richard Schmidt reported there were 100 people at the breakfast on the 10th, 145 at soup night, 120 at the Wilson Family concert. Up coming events are: Valentines Day on the 14th, Rancho Ventana Days on the 6th of March. March 17th is St. Paddy's Day with Radio 60.
